
#### **Building Reports for Instructors**

You can access your Course Evaluations & Surveys account in two ways:


- 1. Log in to Watermark Navigator and select Course Evaluations and Surveys.

### **Response Rate Tracker**


View results of evaluations in real time, including number of respondents out of total enrollments, response rate percentage, and students who opted out






E. **Response Report:** Allows instructor to view responses by individual student (no names of students are listed)

#### **Instructor Results**


